REMEMBER TO VOTE TUESDAY, APRIL 2 Polls are open 7 a.m.-8 p.m. Town of Wausau Municipal Building 161484 County Road Z

The first election for 2024 will be held on April 2. Polls open at 7 a.m. and close at 8 p.m. Voting is held at the Town of Wausau Municipal Building.

If you are not registered to vote, you may do so on election day providing you have resided in the town a minimum of 28 days. Please bring along an approved 'proof of residency' to register. Approved forms include your WI Driver's License, real estate tax bill, paycheck, and bank statement. If unsure, contact the clerk or visit https://myvote.wi.gov. The website is an especially useful tool. You can request an absentee ballot, check your registration status, view the current election ballot, and see your voting history.

Voters are required to show a photo ID and state their name and address aloud for the election inspector. They must also sign the poll book. Voters will have two types of ballots to choose from for voting. Paper ballots or using the touch screen machine called an 'Express Vote' are available for all elections.

If you are interested in becoming an election inspector (poll worker), please leave your name and phone number at the voter registration table. Training is required and provided by the clerk. Questions, please contact Town of Wausau Clerk, Cindy Worden, at 715/297-1157.

SPRING CLEANUP SATURDAY, APRIL 27 8:00-11:00 A.M.

The annual spring cleanup will be held at the Town of Wausau Municipal Building between 8:00 and 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 27. Please bring this newsletter or some other form of ID to show proof of town residency. There will be no charge to drop off metal, recyclables, or large items you can't fit in your garbage cart. Tires, electronics, microwaves, etc. **WILL NOT** be collected. You will need to find alternate ways to dispose of these items.

TOWN OF WAUSAU ANNUAL MEETING TUESDAY, APRIL 16, 7:00 P.M.

On Tuesday, April 16, the annual town meeting will be held at the Town of Wausau Municipal Center. The town chairperson will preside over the meeting. An agenda is not required. If the town board anticipates bringing up a subject at the meeting, an agenda will be posted or published to inform the people of the topic.

To vote at the annual meeting you must be over 18 years old, be a town resident, and be eligible to

vote in regular elections pursuant to Chapter 6 of the Wisconsin Statutes. Property owners who are not residents are not allowed the right to vote. The town chairperson should acknowledge nonresidents and allow them to speak, but only qualified electors can vote. There is no absentee voting or voting by proxy allowed. All actions of



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the meeting must be by vote. Voting can occur by paper ballot, show of hands, standing, or voice vote. Electors vote on which voting method is preferred.

At the annual meeting, the residents will be asked to approve last year's minutes. The annual financial report will be presented. New business as well as old business can be discussed.

We hope that you will attend the annual meeting and be part of our town government!



GARBAGE AND RECYCLING NEWS

As you know, the Town of Wausau contracted with Harter's Fox Valley Disposal the first of this year. We hope all is going well with your service. Just a reminder to be sure to take your cart to the end of driveway the night before your pickup day since pickup can be as early as 4 a.m. the next morning. The garbage trucks are equipped with a lifting device that will empty and return the carts to the same spot. The operator never has to leave the truck cab and controls the entire loading operation from inside the cab. The entire process takes about 15 seconds to complete. Harter's also as a split body truck. The split body trucks pick up the garbage and recyclables at the same time. The garbage and recyclables are separated by using two individual compartments with simultaneous packing. This saves on route costs and eliminates the need for another truck to pick up the recyclables. When you recycle, all paper, cardboard, plastics, metals, and glass can be mixed together in your recyclable cart. FIRE DEPARTMENT NEWS

The Town of Wausau Fire Department Picnic and 5K run/walk fundraiser will be held on Saturday, September 21, at the fire department and town municipal center. Follow our Facebook page for more information as we get closer to the event: *Town of Wausau Fire Department*

The Fire Department is happy to report a grant was received from the DNR to help purchase wildland fighting gear and tools.

CHANGE YOUR BATTERIES: Do not forget to change your smoke and carbon monoxide (CO) alarm batteries yearly. CO alarms are typically good for 10 years, and then need to be replaced.

THINKING ABOUT BURNING? Please visit the town website at <u>https://townofwausau.com</u> for the burning ordinance. It could cost you up to \$500 if the Fire Department is called out to your property for not following the ordinance. Legal burning permits are issued by the Town only, not by the DNR. Please contact Ben Schlund at 715/297-3396 or Kyle Borchardt at 715/340-3561 for more information or a burning permit.

FALSE ALARMS: Please remember to properly cancel a FALSE alarm if your alarm system goes off. If it goes off, the alarm company will need the code that you gave them. Your alarm company will call you at the number you provided. This may be an out of state number so please do not ignore it. Once you give the correct code, they will contact 911 to properly cancel the call. If you do not provide the correct code, the Fire Department will show up. If you need to test your system, please call your alarm company to put the system in test mode, so the fire department doesn't respond.
